Important information and rules pertaining to admission for the session are as given below:

The candidate who applies for admission is advised to carefully read the same and it shall be presumed that he/she agrees to abide by the same.

I. Duration of the Programme - 36 Weeks (23.09.2024 to 30.05.2025)

II. Course Mode: - Full Time (Regular Classes)

III. Medium of Instruction / Course - English.

IV. Eligibility:

- Graduation in any Discipline (Pass in any Degree) from Recognized University.
- Age not more than 45 years as on the commencement of the programme.
- V. Course Content The Course Consists of Two Semesters.

- VI. Regular Classes The regular classes will be conducted on working days.
- VII. Class Timings 10.00 A.M to 5.00 P.M
- VIII. Holidays Saturdays, Sundays and Government Notified holidays.
- IX. Compulsory Attendance 80% of the total working days of classroom sessions. Biometric Attendance System will be maintained and Attendance of the candidates will be reviewed every month.

X. Examination and Assessment

- a) **Internal Assessment** (50 Marks) is based on Case Presentation, Group Discussion, In-basket exercise, Quiz & Written Test.
- b) **End Semester Examinations** (50 Marks) in Each Paper.
- c) The candidates should secure at least 40% for pass in respect of each subject, including the internal assessment. However, the aggregate percentage of marks in each semester should be 45% for declaring a candidate successful /pass. If, under any circumstances, the candidate is unable to appear for the examination, he/ she should be treated as failed in that subject.

Observation Study Report and Presentation

As an integral part of the course, the candidates have to undertake compulsorily one week Observation Study Visit in any cooperative institutions and should submit a study report and presentation for the Marks of 50. Those who are absent in the study visit, will have to take up the study visit as per ICM rules.

Project and Viva-Voce

As an integral part of the course, the participants have to undertake project work in a cooperative institution and to submit a report for the assessment of 100 marks.

The external viva-voce will be conducted for the evaluation of 50 marks.

Gradation

The candidates will be placed under the following categories/grades based on the overall percentage of marks obtained in the examination.

75% and above - Distinction

65% but below 75% - First Class

55% but below 65% - Second Class

45% but below 55% - Third Class

Less than 45% - Failed, Reappearance is required

Exams for the Failed Candidates

The failed candidates will be allowed a maximum of three attempts to clear the examination subject to the condition that he/she must clear it within a maximum of 2 years from the close of the course. Supplementary examination will be conducted with the consent to the Director within the duration of the programme. The candidate has to pay Rs.500 per subject.

Course Fee

Rs. 25,000 + 18% GST (Non Refundable). payable at the time of admission.

Selection Procedure

The approved capacity of the programme is 50 per batch. If, the number of applicants is below 50, then admission will be based on first come, first serve basis.

If, the number of Applicants exceeds 50, an entrance exam will be conducted at ICM, Madurai campus to select the candidates on merit basis.

Capacity of the Programme

50 participants per batch. Additional Batch will be started based on the demand.

Other Information

- ❖ Limited Hostel Facilities are available only for Women candidates that will be considered with the extent (in kms) to which their hometown is located from Madurai. However there are many private homes/residence are available for affordable rent around areas.
- Read the instructions and guidelines carefully before applying to the programme.

 Interested candidates who wish to pursue the course can register themselves by submitting the online application that is available as Google form link in the website.

 No applications will be issued from the office and No other forms of submission of applications will not be accepted. (Detailed Guidelines for sending the application are given in Annexure-II)
- ❖ Candidates who are waiting for the result of qualifying examination may also apply for admission with the clear understanding that their admission will remain provisional until they fulfill all the eligibility requirements of the concerned programme on the commencement date.
- ❖ A candidate whose qualifying examination is not recognized by any university, as identified during the verification shall not be eligible for admission. All such admissions (if provided) shall stand cancelled and fees paid (if any) will also be forfeited. The original certificates as a mandatory requirement during the verification process of the Institute.
- No correspondence shall be made to a candidate not selected for admission.
- ❖ All students are expected to abide by the rules and regulations, code of conduct, policy and procedures etc. governing the students, which will be laid down by the Institute from time to time.
- Eligibility rules as specified for course shall be strictly followed and shall not be relaxed under any circumstance. Candidate should satisfy himself/herself that he/she fulfills the eligibility requirements prescribed for admission to the programme.
